Reminder: you **cannot U-turn in front of the school.**

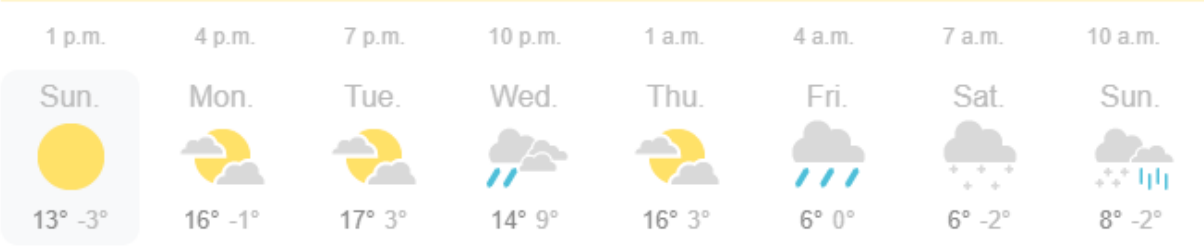
